Metered Parking

There are meters on Jefferson and Vermont along the edge of campus. On Sundays, most are unrestricted but please READ POSTED SIGNS before you leave your car.

Campus Parking: \$10/day

Drive to Entrance 6 (on Vermont at 36th Place) and buy a "day pass." Park in the structure just to the right after you enter (PSA on map). From PSA, it is a short walk to the reception venue and a slightly longer walk to the School of Cinematic Arts.

On Campus/Walking Directions: see campus map below/over.

NOTE: There's a great deal of construction on campus this fall. To avoid the closures, follow the path marked on this map.

Screenings - School of Cinematic Arts, SCI 106

- The School of Cinematic Arts, SCI building is at the corner of West 34th Street and McClintock Avenue (in yellow C-D/2-3 on attached map).
- Enter SCI from West 34th Street via the courtyard between the SCI and SCB buildings.
- SCI 106 is on the ground level.

Reception – Lobby, Grace Ford Salvatori ("Ford Salvatori" on map)

- GFS is at C-D/4-5 on the attached map, a short walk down Watt Way, passing Heritage Hall and Cromwell Field before turning right onto Childs Way.
- Enter the building on Childs Way, across from the track oval (Cromwell Field)
